**Conditions of Entry and Participation in the Mary River Torch Relay–Paradise Dam, September 6-7, 2008.**

**Welcome to the Mary River Torch Relay – Paradise Dam. We hope you enjoy the evening/camp as we relay the GetUp! Climate Torch.**

- As a Duty of Care, we are responsible for ensuring that everyone going to the Paradise dam camp is aware of the potential hazards. All participants are required to read, sign and date this form.
- Participants in the Paradise Dam evening event/camp do so entirely at their own risk. If you hurt yourself or someone else, the Save the Mary River Coordinating Group and the property owner are not liable.
- **Buses will depart from Traveston Crossing at 1pm.**
- Campers must supply their own tent, eating utensils, pillow, sleeping bag, bucket and chair. Bring warm clothes, change of clothes, and a torch. No showers are available at Camp Paradise. Variable water quality including Blue-green algae hazard makes the untreated dam water unsuitable for swimming, drinking or personal use. Tank water is available for drinking and washing.
- Catering will be provided: Dinner Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September. Breakfast Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September and Lunch Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September. Vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals will be provided. Participants with unique dietary requirements will need to provide their own meals/supplements.
- All participants must have sturdy shoes to protect their feet, wear a hat, sunscreen and bring a water bottle. Tank water is available at Camp Paradise.
- Children must be supervised by adults at all times.
- All vehicles must stay on mowed tracks/roadways and use designated parking areas or park legally on the public roads.
- Toilets are provided at the site.
- Please follow all instructions by your guide/hosts.
- We take pride in our beautiful environment... Please take all rubbish home.
