  - Meeting of Committee with Director General, Bob McCarthy at 9 am on Thursday
  - Govt Committee to be established as a mechanism to research and elicit facts regarding the proposed dam. Committee to involve affected MP's and chaired by the Minister. Despite concerns, does provide an opportunity to get issues into Parliament and have them considered seriously, rather than being fobbed off. More details to follow
  - Community Forums conducted by DNR – Lyn volunteered to coordinate attendance by members of the Committee (not to assist DNR, to assist the community members and protect their interests)
  - Car Rally next weekend at Imbil – good TV coverage – Tony arranging for signs and banners in prominent places.

  - Census planning now well underway.
