## **What are the conditions of membership?**

### Full Members

- must be at least 18 years of age.
- may vote at general meetings.
- are eligible for election to the Management Committee.

### Associate Members

- must be at least 18 years of age.
- do not vote at general meetings.
- are not eligible for election to the Management Committee.

### Junior Members

- must be under 18 years of age.
- do not vote at general meetings.
- are not eligible for election to the Management Committee.

## **Does the Committee have insurance cover?**

Yes. Our Public Liability Insurance cover is \$10 Million. The policy covers the organisation, its employees and volunteers from their legal liability to third parties for personal injury and/or property damage if proven legally liable or negligent as defined in the policy.
