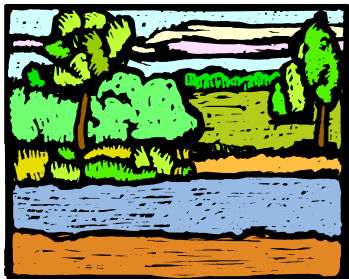

 - Visit from Stephen Hagan, Kullilli representative, co-author of *Melly and the Bilby*

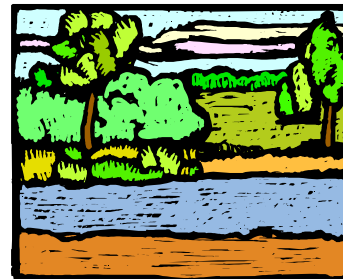
